President's Letter

Dear Artists,

A little note about me. I get excited about the creation of any form of visual art. I want to explore and embrace it all and encourage others to do the same. That must be why I take Our Mission Statement to heart: *"The Summerville Artist Guild is dedicated to stimulating interest in Visual Arts, encouraging all levels of artistic ability, and promoting Art education in the Summerville, South Carolina community"*.

I recently read an article that explained why an artist would want to gather up their supplies, head out to the parks or the woods and deal with the elements to paint. I am not a great landscape artist but I always like to go. And I thought this was a great explanation for why I do it.

Almost any artist will tell you that there's a certain appeal to working outdoors that can't be found anywhere else. With each season brings new focus, light and challenges to entice us to leave our studios for the great outdoors.

The thrill of working en plein air is that you can shake up your routine and work differently than you might usually. Use the change in location to try new techniques, such as working on a smaller scale or focusing predominantly on light and other atmospheric qualities.

You can spend all day looking for a "perfect" composition that just doesn't exist. Embrace the reality around you such as power lines or even debris-and open yourself up to telling interesting stories with new subjects. Walk around, sit a spell, and really soak in the landscape around you.

Best of all you don't have to do it alone.

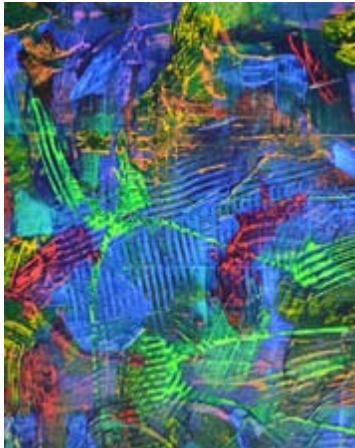

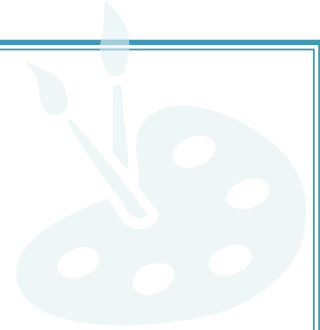
Tuesday Painting Group 9am-12am
